Assault Course	External	Danger of injury from hard surfaces.	The inflatable must never be mounted unless the inflatable bed is fully inflated whether the inflatable is in operation or not as this can lead to serious injury.	1	4	4	ensure safety crash mats are kept in installed positions
Assault Course	External	Tripping over anchorage points, spare equipment, electrical cables	Anchor points used as per manufacturers instructions. 16x pegs for outside use. Sandbags for inside. Assault Course	External	Risk of fire from Petrol Blower / Generator (when used)	Blowers/generators to be filled with fuel on delivery, Inflatable is fire retardant. Should refuelling be required inflatable must be closed for use, generator turned off and cooled down before refuelling.	1	5	5	All fuel, is to be stored in suitable marked containers, and kept in a safe location, away from children and out of direct sunlight.
